QLDTraffic Icon Guide

The website displays **six event types** (refer to the image on the right) that appears on QLDTraffic website when roads remain passable. *(Important reminder: Road conditions can change rapidly due to flooding, prioritise safety and remember, if it's flooded, forget it)*

The below **red balloon icons** represent **all event types** when **closures** are involved. The icon adjusts based on the **impact subtypes** (refer to the image below). **White balloon icons** indicate **future closures**.

Yellow triangle icons represent **roadworks, special events and flooding events** when **restrictions** are in place. The icon changes depending on the **impact subtype** (Refer to the image below). **White balloon icons** indicate **future restrictions**.

Road restrictions

The **Blue Line** on the QLDTraffic map represents a **linear (section-based)** rather than a single point location. It is used to visually identify the portion of roadway which may be impacted, providing better awareness of the road affected by a traffic alert.
